Homework

Homework-please be sure that you are going over homework with your child every night. It is very important that they complete their homework in order to practice the skills that they have learned in class. Email or Dojo me if you are having issues with homework, I am here to help! I will be collecting homework on Fridays as a grade. If you child forgets their homework, they may turn it in on Monday!

<u>Reading Homework</u>-Students are to complete a weekly reading log where they will be expected to read for a minimum of 20 minutes every evening. This log will be submitted Friday (or the last day of the school week) and returned on the following Monday.

<u>Spelling Homework-</u>There is weekly homework for students to practice their spelling words. They will receive their spelling words on Friday and the spelling tests will be on the following Friday.

<u>Math Homework</u>-Math homework is given weekly, but unlike spelling homework, we will check it every day. Students can complete it at their own pace, but they should have Monday's homework completed for Tuesday, Tuesday's homework completed for Wednesday, etc.

*Students have the option of working on homework every day during dismissal.
