#### Math

# Language Arts

Students are learning about how animals are classified. They are learning about characteristics that animals possess including vertebrates, warm and cold blooded, and physical features. We will have a Domain 2 test the week of October 2 lst.

#### Science and Social Studies

Our science unit is integrated with Language Arts, Students are working on a research project on a vertebrate of their choice and reviewing characteristics of vertebrates.

### Homework

Reading Homework-Students are to complete a weekly reading log with daily questions. I will update our Reading Log for the second quarter!

Math Homework-Math homework is given weekly, but unlike reading homework, we will check it every day. Students can complete it at their own pace, but they should have Monday's homework completed for Tuesday, Tuesday's homework completed for Wednesday, etc.
