Math

We have completed our unit on multi digit addition and begun our unit on subtraction. In this unit, we will learn how to regroup to subtract and how to subtract over zeros. We will continue to practice previously learned skills as well. There will be a quiz on this chapter the week of October 2 Ist and we will have a unit test Thursday!

Language Arts

Students are learning about how animals are classified. They are learning about characteristics that animals possess including vertebrates, warm and cold blooded, and physical features. We will have a Domain 2 test the week of October 2 Ist.

Science and Social Studies

Our science unit is integrated with Language Arts, Students are working on a research project on a vertebrate of their choice and reviewing characteristics of vertebrates.

Homework

Homework-please be sure that you are going over homework with your child every night. It is very important that they complete their homework in order to practice the skills that they have learned in class. Email or Dojo me if you are having issues with homework, I am here to help!

Reading Homework-Students are to complete a weekly reading log with daily questions. I will update our Reading Log for the second quarter!

<u>Spelling Homework-</u> There is weekly homework for students to practice their spelling words. They will receive their spelling words on Friday and the spelling tests will be on the following Friday.

Math Homework-Math homework is given weekly, but unlike reading homework, we will check it every day. Students can complete it at their own pace, but they should have Monday's homework completed for Tuesday, Tuesday's homework completed for Wednesday, etc.
